The SMU Trade Workshop 2022 is organized by School of Economics, Singapore Management University (SMU). The workshop also provides a forum for local economists to present their work and to collect feedbacks from the field experts. This year, we are organizing the workshop surrounding four themes --- Trade and Developing Economies, Trade and Financial Markets, Trade Policy, and Trade and Labor Market Implications. The workshop is held over a period of two days from **3 March to 4 March, 2022**.
