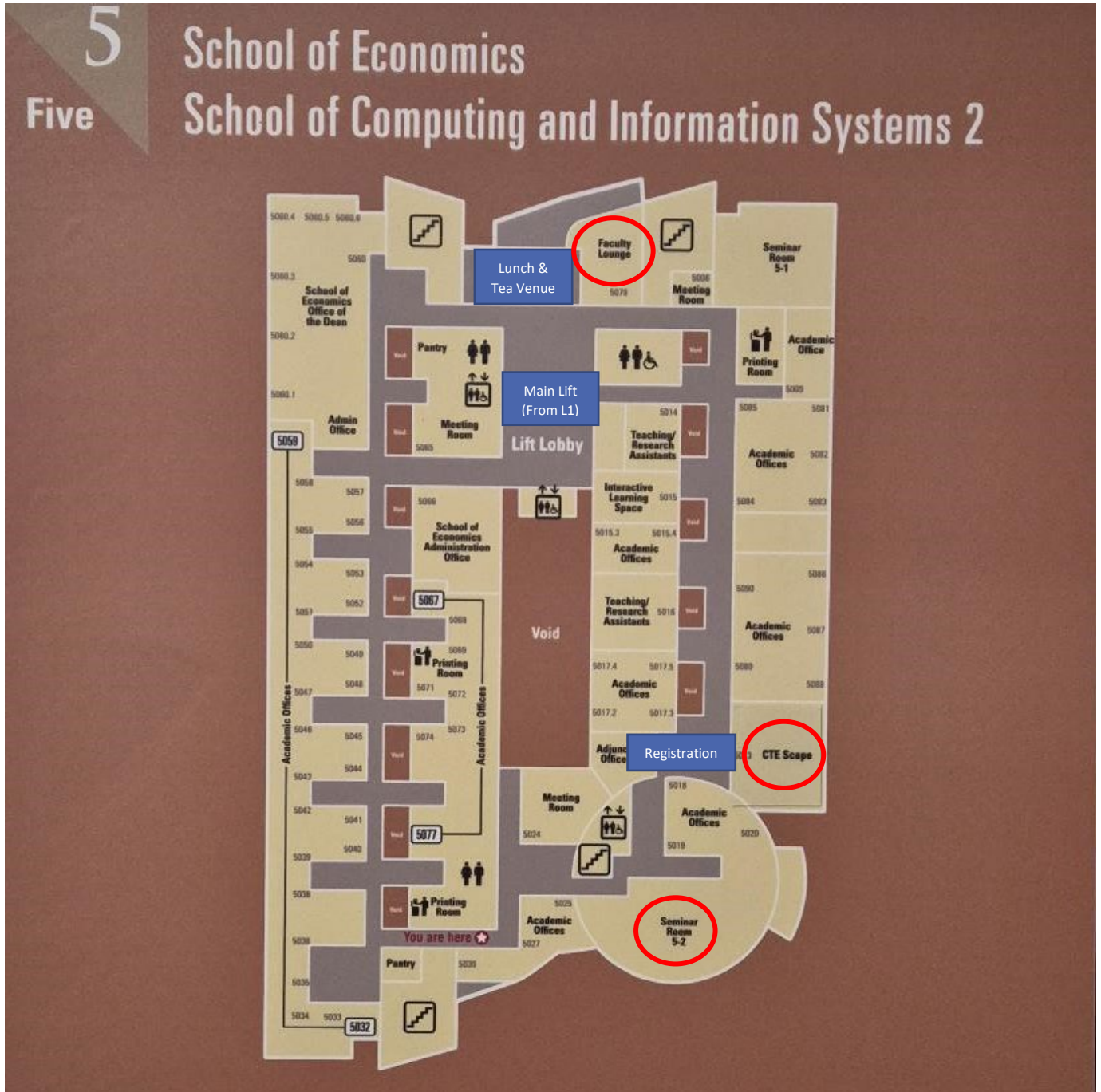

*Location of keynote sessions, parallel sessions and registration venue.

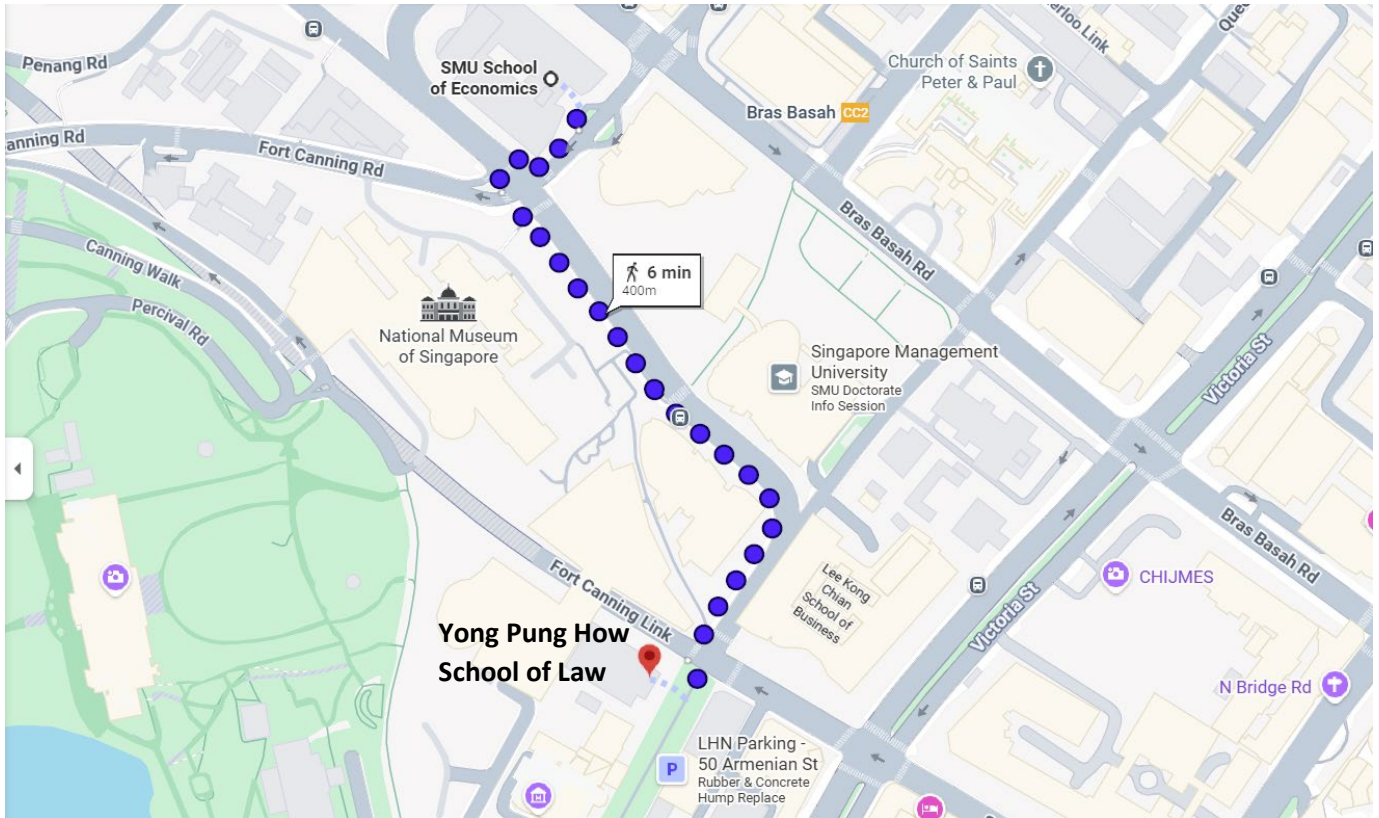

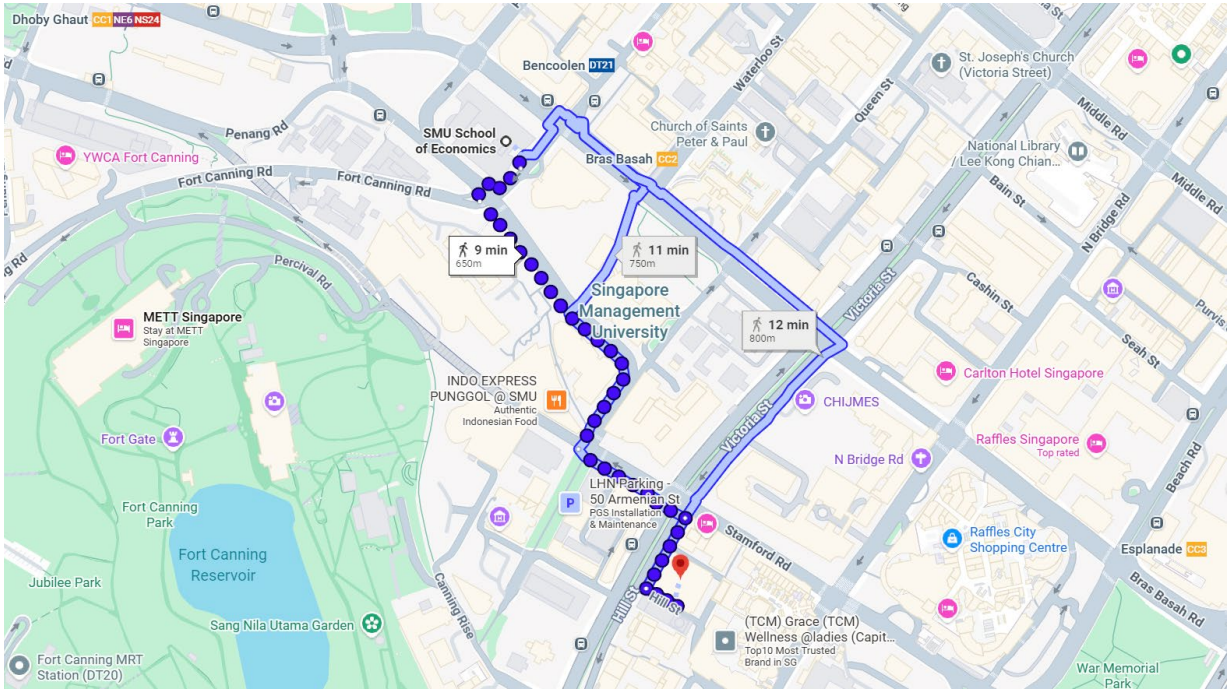

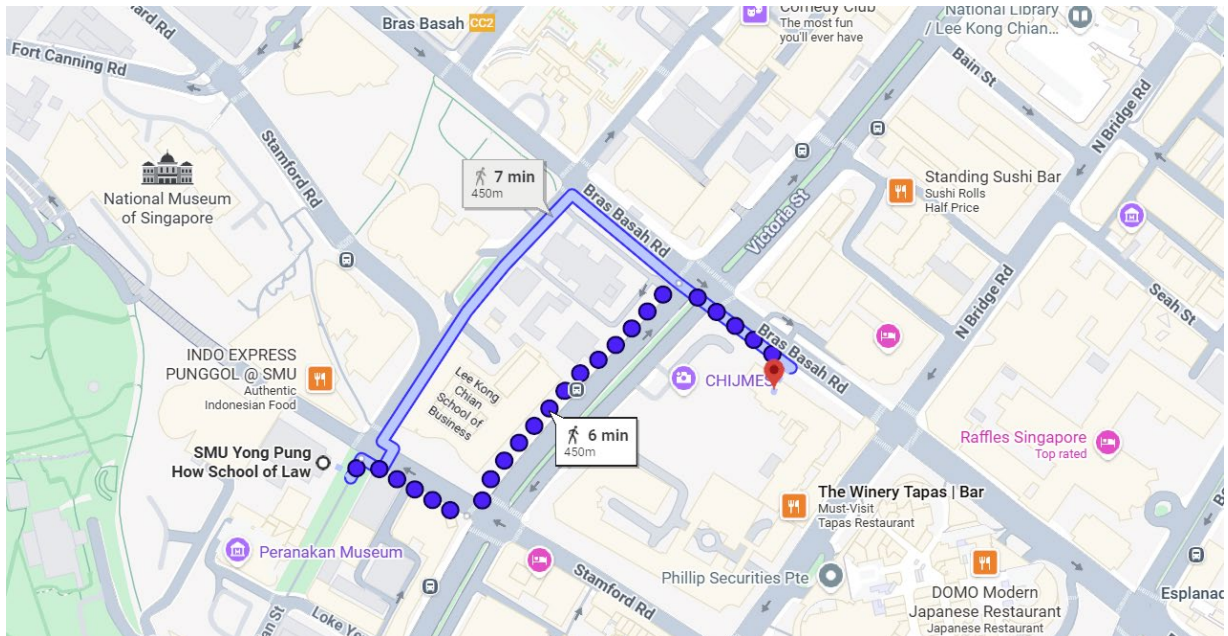


Directions to Restaurants from SOE
